

Let's talk about inflammation



Inflammation gets a bit of a bad reputation — but the truth is, it's one of your body's most important helpers. It's actually part of how you heal.

Whenever you pick up an injury, an infection, or come into contact with something irritating, your body springs into action. White blood cells (your built-in defence team) and other helpful substances rush to the affected spot to fight off anything harmful and start repairing the damage. That whole rescue effort is what we call inflammation.

In plain terms: *Inflammation is your body's natural first-aid response. The redness, warmth or swelling you notice is simply a sign that your body has sent help to where it's needed.*



As uncomfortable — and yes, as painful — as it can be, inflammation is an essential step on the road to feeling better. The tricky part is that most of us reach straight for painkillers, when what our body really needs is a little help to *speed up* the healing instead.

Pain is simply your body's way of letting you know something still needs attention — so why silence that message? It's a bit like a road sign warning of a bump ahead. You wouldn't ignore it, would you? This is exactly where the Oska Pulse comes in.
